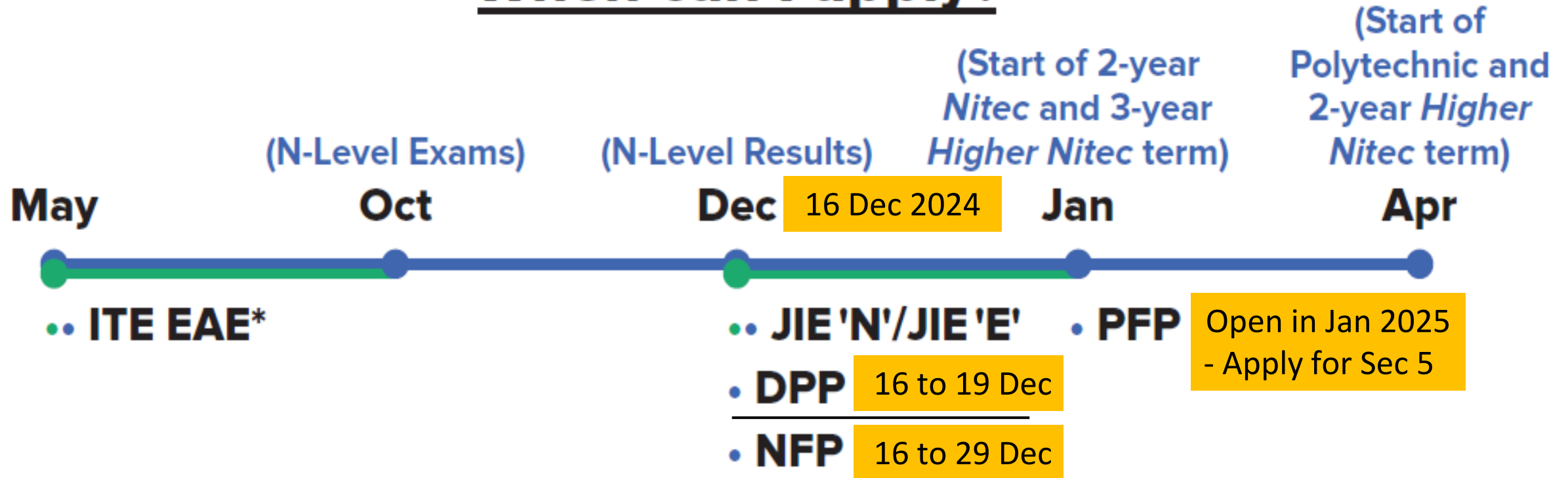

- Students should report to school on Tuesday, 2 January 2025 for Sec 5N(A).

Students who are eligible for PFP and are **interested in PFP**:

The PFP Admissions Exercise (PFPAE) is conducted after the release of the O-Level results. If you are eligible for PFP, you will receive Form P containing your PFP PIN. You can log in to the PFPAE portal using the PFP PIN and submit your 5 choices.

5N(A)

- Students who are interested in the **PFP** and are eligible should **first progress to Sec 5N(A)**.
- Apply for Sec 5 through <https://forms.moe.edu.sg/forms/vV5LaP>
- All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes up till **end Jan 2025**.

Apply PFP in Jan

- They may then apply for the PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in **Jan 2025**.

If successful – withdraw from 5N(A)

- If their application is successful, they will withdraw from Sec 5N(A) by **end Jan 2025**.

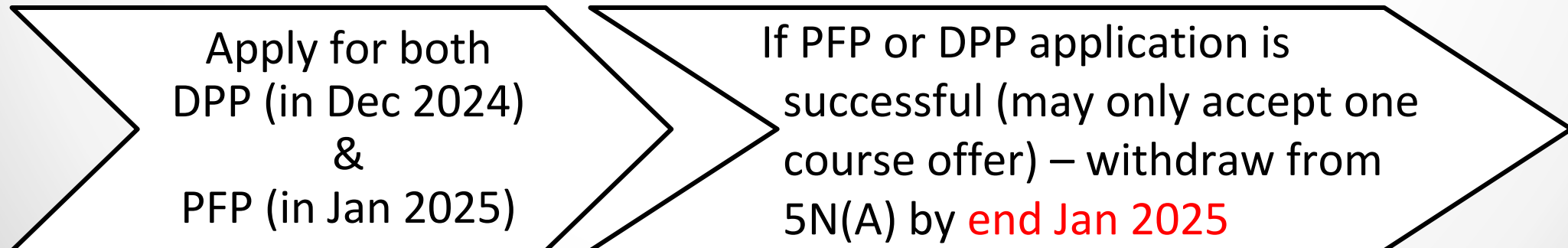

When to apply?

Jan 2025, after O-level results release.
Concurrently with Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE).

Who are eligible? What to expect?

Sec 4N(A) students in 2024

Eligibility: Gross ELMAB3 \leq 12 & course requirements.

Eligible Sec 4 N(A) students will receive a copy of '**Form 'P'**'.

Students can apply for **up to 5** PFP choices.

How many?

About 2000 places set aside across all 5 polys.

What courses?

More than **80%** of Polytechnic Diploma courses offered under PFP.

Posting

'N' and 'O'

PFP / DPP / Sec 5

While waiting for PFP eligibility in Jan 2025, students can either:

- Progress to S5 in Jan

What is it?

One-year bridging programme that prepares students for NAFA diploma programme

What to submit?

Depending on courses:

- Portfolio
- Personal statement
- Audition and or
- Aptitude Tests

Check NAFA website for details.

Who are eligible?

Eligibility for Sec 4N(A):

- **Gross ELMAB3 \leq 15**
- **If EL \geq 4:** Required to attend interview
- Caters to students of the Sec 4N(A) cohort in the preceding year (i.e. 2024)

Conditional

Successful applicants are given **conditional** offer of admission to diploma course. Upon successful completion of NFP → progress to chosen diploma

When N-Level results are released.

Posting

Application outcome sent via email within 4-6 weeks after portfolio submission / interview / Audition or Admission Test.

'N'- and 'O'-

Students can use S4 prelim results for O-Level subjects that are pending results release in application for NFP. O-level grade of F9 will not be counted towards ELMAB3 aggregate.

Acad Calendar

NFP is a 35-wk programme that runs from Mar to Feb of the following year and is divided into three trimesters.

DPP & JIE-N

Eligible students can apply for courses under JIE-H and JIE-N.

However, if DPP application is successful (JIE'H'), student will not be offered a course under JIE'N'.

Eligibility vs Placement

DPP & PFP

If student has accepted DPP and is also offered PFP in Jan 2025, he/she will need to apply for withdrawal from the DPP course and apply for refund of DPP fees, subject to ITE's approval.
